Objectives & Topics

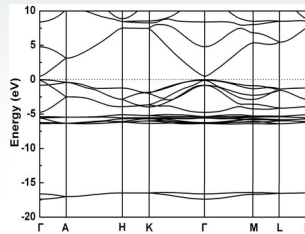

The authors are invited to submit papers on the following topics:

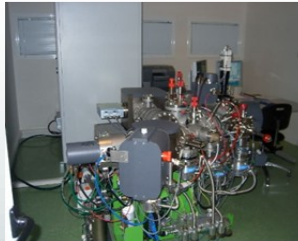
