- Achieving sustainability through project activities
- Expectations from RMSU in support of sustainability of projects

Through project activities (1):

- Horizontal:
- Quality assurance during project lifetime
- Creation of linkages:
- > Ensure institutional linkages after project ends;
- create linkages within MEDA Water group;
- > create platforms through networking

Through project activities (2):

- Advocacy & development of capacities:
- Create cases that convince governments/donors to continue funding;
- advocate for adoption of project results (approaches, technology) by government and authorities;
- develop technical (& social) capacities in host institutions (& partners)

Through project activities (3):

- Knowledge management:
- Advocate knowledge transfer & dissemination of information
- Conduct awareness raising activities
- After project ends:
- Enhance monitoring of application of results
- Work on financial mechanisms to continue project activities (ex. Auto-financing)

Expectations from RMSU (1):

- MEDA Water Projects:
- Create learning environment within MEDA Water group (now!)
- Create synergies and strengthen networking between MEDA Water projects and their partners
- Support of projects:
- Support projects to improve performance & impact (ex. review logframe)
- Support projects for a better promotion of their results

Expectations from RMSU (2):

- Relations with EMWIS:
- Strengthen linkage with EMWIS
- Use EMWIS website for dissemination of outcomes of MEDA Water projects <u>after end of all projects</u> (Sept. 07)
- Lobbying:
- Lobby with European Commission and other donors for continuation of successful projects
- Lobby for continuation of MEDA Water Programme with governments and national authorities
